Because of this oversight, the Pagoda management gave us a couple platters of prime rib for each of our tables. We collected \$16.50 per person during the buffet. But when we got the tab, the cost was more than we had collected, so we collected another \$3.00 to make it \$19.50 per person.

The actual tab for the buffet, a few drinks, 18.0% service charge and tax came out to \$425.75. Divided by 23 persons, this comes out to \$18.51 per person, so we had collected \$1.00 too much from each attendee. Instead of reimbursing each attendee, (\$23.00 total), I suggest that we deposit the \$23.00 in the class treasury.
